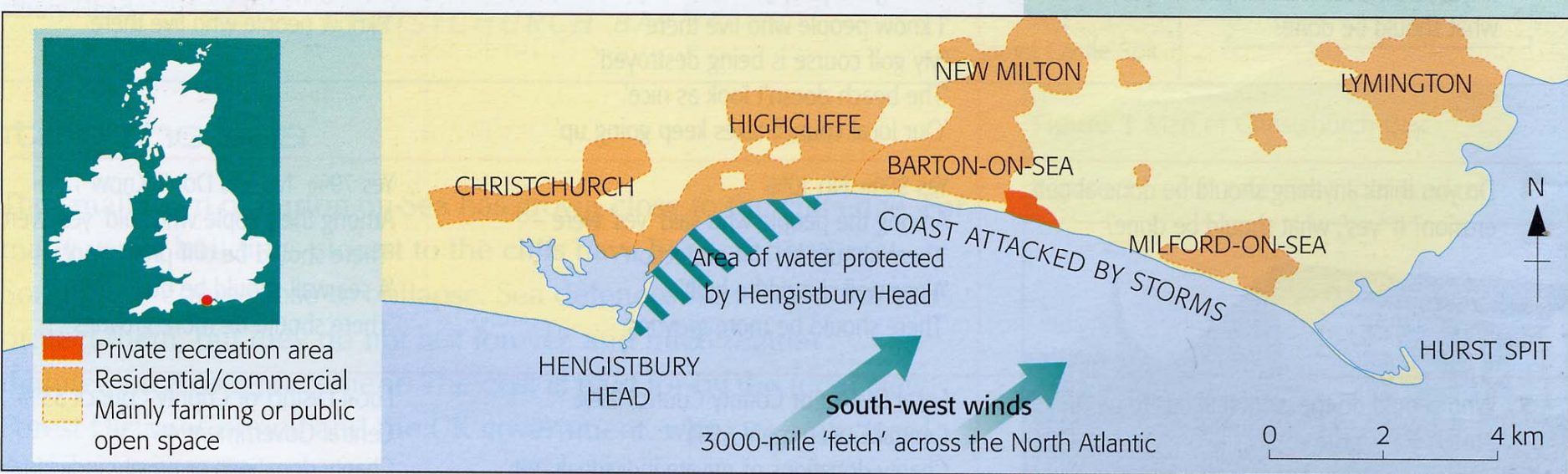




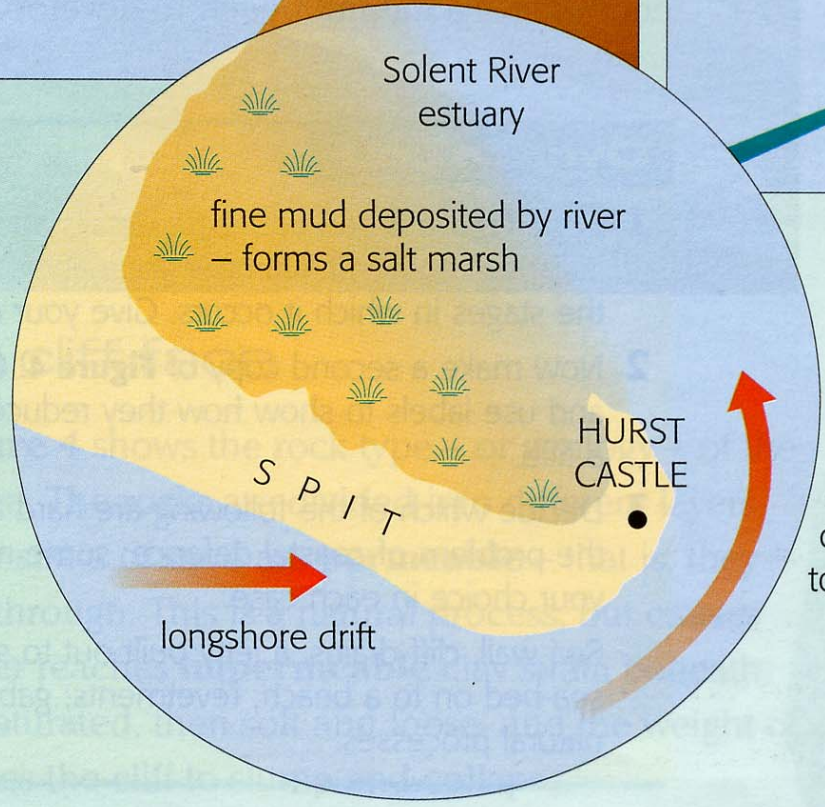
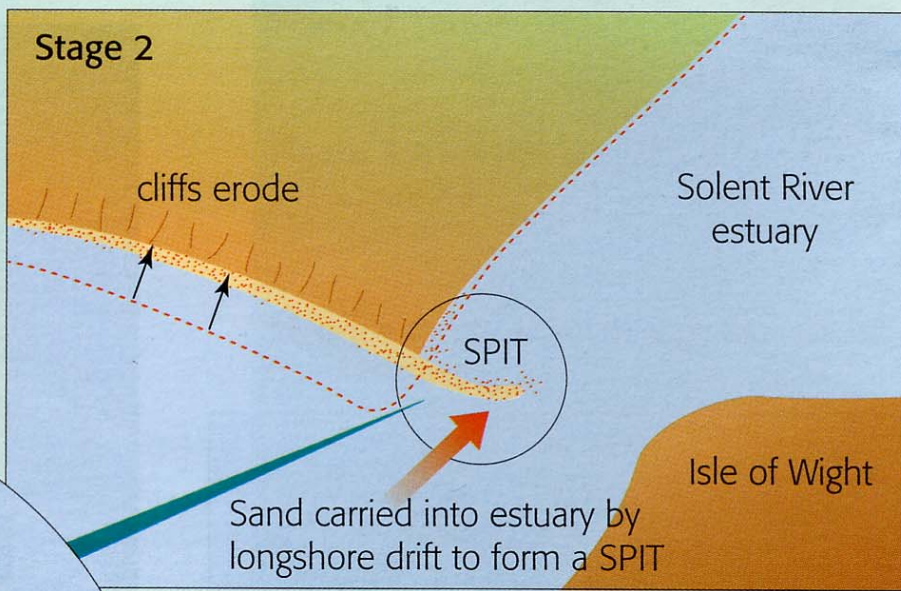
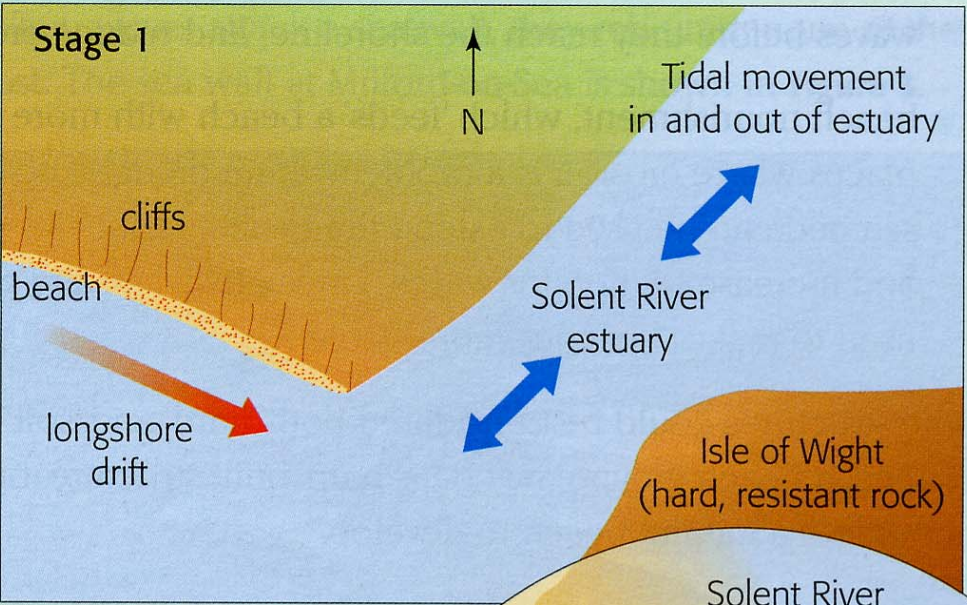
A building firm applied to the local council for permission to transport materials from a point R and S want to reduce the transport of material along the beach? Why do you think their application was turned down?
