**Year 12 AS English Visit – Aspects of Narrative in Poetry Lectures, London on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2012.**

The English Department is organising a trip for Year 12 AS students as part of the Curriculum Enrichment Programme.

The visit involves a day of several lectures providing information concerning exam guidance and practice, analytical skills focused on narrative devices, specific to poetry, and Assessment Objectives.

The visit will directly link to, and help to enhance the AS English Literature course. Travel to London will be by coach. Students will need to meet at Beaumont School at 9.00 am. The lectures will run from 11am until 3.30pm. We aim to arrive back by 5pm. Students should bring a packed lunch or money with which to purchase something to eat/drink. They should also bring a notebook and something to write with as well as their anthologies.

The cost of the trip will be £25 which covers travel expenses and the lectures themselves. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £25 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the children. If you wish to discuss financial assistance or a possible extension on the payment deadline please contact the Finance Office before Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February.

I should be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return **by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February**, cheques to be made payable to Beaumont School. You can send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your child's name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it. This should be posted in the appropriate box outside the Finance Office. Please ensure that this deadline is adhered to.
