Re: Drama visit to the Globe Theatre and Bankside Tour – afternoon and evening Wednesday 7th September 2011

We have had the good fortune to obtain tickets to see the Globe Theatre's production of Shakespeare's 'Much Ado About Nothing' on Wednesday 7th September 2011. It is highly recommended that all A2 Drama students visit this area and attend a production at the Globe as they will be writing about it in detail in their Unit 4 written exam, in the summer, which comprises 20% of their overall marks at A2.

The cost of this trip will be £21 for the Bankside Tour and the play. Students will have time for lunch at the end of Period 5 and then we will travel by train to London. Students should bring money for travel (approximately £10), the programme and any refreshments or meals they might require. As travel will be by public transport, please encourage your child to wear sensible footwear and provide plenty of sustenance.

Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £21 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students.

I should be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return it as soon as possible, cheques to be made payable to Beaumont School. You can send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it. This should be placed in the box marked 'Much Ado About Nothing' outside the Finance Office by no later than **Monday 13th June**.
