Fast-track French Easter School 2009

I am writing to give you some more information about the Fast-track French Easter School next week. The Easter school will be held on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> April, and will begin at 9am and finish at 2.30pm. There will be two groups, and we will be in rooms 64 and 67 in the Languages block.

Please find attached the timetable for the two days. The aim of the Easter school is to provide pupils with an intensive revision programme which will help to prepare them for their oral exams (which will be held on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> May). In the morning sessions, we will do a range of activities to revise the four topic areas (we are currently working on the fifth topic area in lessons). In the sessions we will also focus on specific grammar points. During the afternoon sessions the focus will be on practising role play cards and conversation which will be very useful for pupils in the run up to their oral exams. Miriam, the French assistant, will be present on both days and so every pupil will have an allotted one-to-one session with her.

Breakfast will be provided on both days and pupils do not need to wear school uniform. Please ensure that your child brings the following items:

- packed lunch
- notebook (A5 or larger)
- pencil case
- their GCSE conversation booklet
