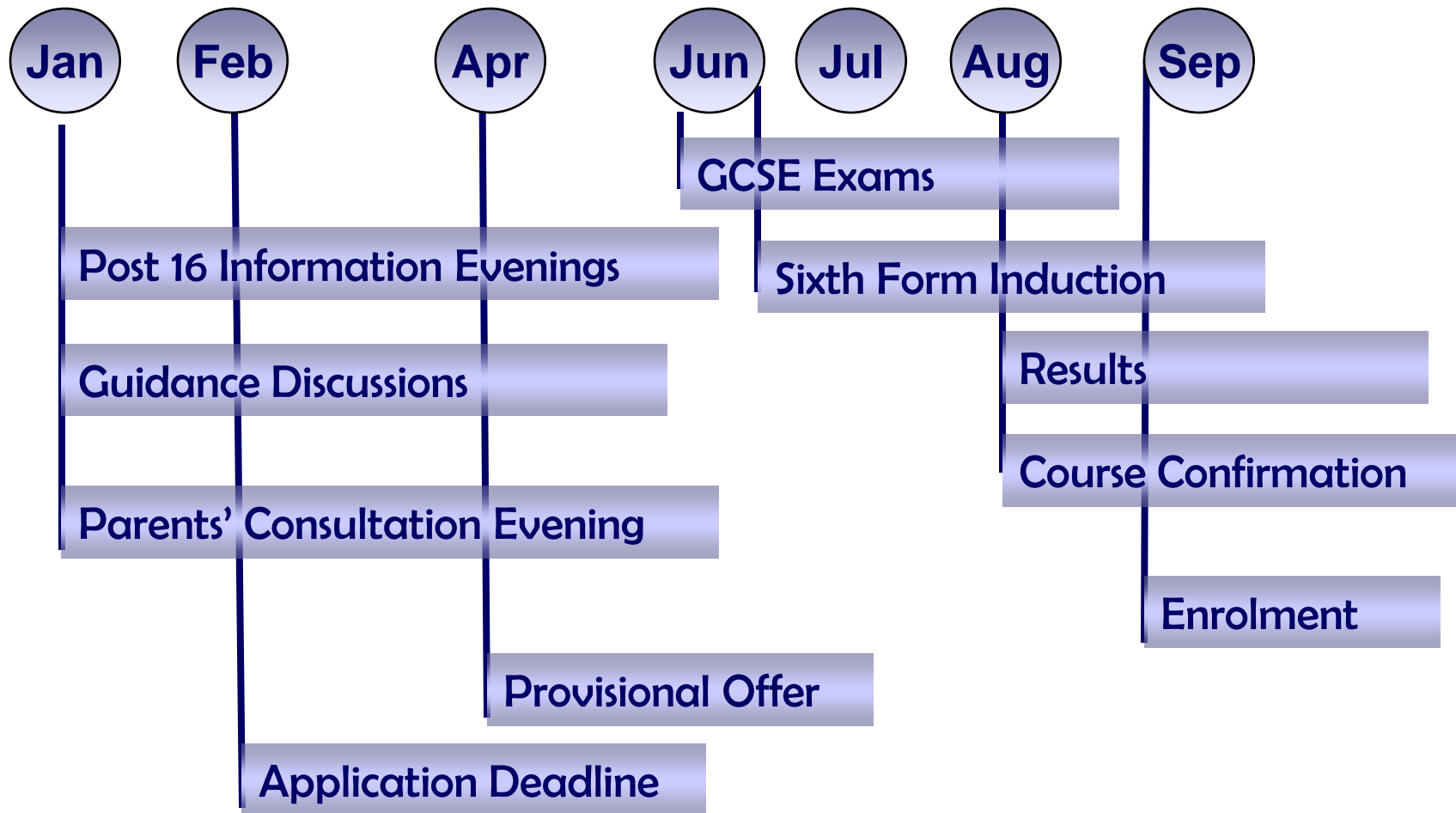

Calculating Average Points Scores

A*	58
A	52
B	46
C	40
D	34
E	28
F	22
G	16

Calculate the total points gained and divide by the number of GCSEs taken.

Performance across ALL GCSEs important.

Average Points Score:

43 to 58 (B-A*)

39 to 43 (C-B)

Subject Choice:

4 AS levels

3 AS levels; 2 BTECs;
or 1 BTEC and 1 AS level
