Section A requires sketches

Useful for sketches/flowcharts

diagrams/charts you might want to change

3. Ruler



4. Rubber


5. Highlighter pen



Avoid losing marks because you haven't understood key clues in the questions

Section A – Follow a specification and design a bread and/or dip product*

- Worth 25% of the marks
- We know what the questions will be about
- Should take you 30 mins total
- You need to learn a recipe by heart
- You will need to make sketches and label designs

 Should be EASY marks, IF YOU REVISE and PRACTISE sketches and plans that include the specifications and full QC points/method

Tip – read the specification carefully, they may ask you to sketch both, they may ask you to sketch only the bread

Section B – Random questions from anything in the revision guide

- Worth 75% of the marks
- We DON'T know what the questions will be about
- Should take you 1 ½ hrs to complete
- **Read and highlight key words in the questions, note the number of marks available, remember the 1 mark = “1 fact, one reason, one explanation, one justification” rule**
- Practise using key words and terminology
- revise key information from your year 10 exercise book and revision guide thoroughly. Prioritise key chapters (e.g. sensory testing, healthy eating)
- Never leave a space on a paper – have a go at everything
