Year 10 History Visit –‘Jack the Ripper Walk’ – CED Tuesday 10th November 2009

The History Department is organising a visit for Year 10 students. The visit involves participating in a guided walk of the sites of the Jack the Ripper murders, which took place in London in 1888. The walk is organised and led by Discovery Tours and Events Ltd, a company with many years’ experience in this field.

The visit will directly link to, and help to enhance the GCSE History coursework assignment on Jack the Ripper which students will be working on later in Year 11. Travel will be by train and tube to London. Students will need to meet at St Albans City Station at 9.30 am. We aim to arrive back by 3.30 pm. Students should wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch.

The cost of the trip will be £11 which covers travel expenses and the guided walk. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £11 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the children. If you wish to discuss financial assistance or a possible extension on the payment deadline please contact the Finance Office before Thursday 22nd October.

I should be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return **by Thursday 22nd October**, cheques to be made payable to Beaumont School. You can send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your child’s name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it. This should be posted in the box marked ‘Year 10 Curriculum Enrichment Day’ outside the Finance Office.
