Re: Tate Britain Art Gallery Visit – Curriculum Enrichment Day, Tuesday 10th November 2009

We have the opportunity to take Year 10 students to visit the Tate Britain Art Gallery in London on **Tuesday 10th November 2009**. This visit will particularly benefit Art GCSE and BTEC students in the development of ideas for their projects and allow all students to see at first hand original pieces of artwork.

All pupils can bring a packed lunch or buy lunch at the Gallery. GCSE and BTEC students must bring with them their Sketch book and drawing pencils. We will leave school at 9.00 am promptly and pupils should register in the Technology Foyer at 8.30 am on Tuesday 10th November.

The cost of this visit will be £6.00 per student which covers the coach fare in to London. Entry to the gallery is free of charge. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the visit will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £6.00 to school funds. It is entirely up to you whether you wish to contribute. However, if all parents are not prepared to make this contribution then the visit may not be able to take place for any of the students.

I should be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return it to school as soon as possible, cheques to be made payable to Beaumont School. You can send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name, form and title of the trip clearly written on it.
