Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: Contributions to Curriculum Enrichment activities – Year 11

During the course of the year pupils participate in a variety of activities designed to complement and enrich the normal curriculum. This year there will be five Curriculum Enrichment Days as detailed on the attached sheet (NB: Year 11 pupils will not be in school for the July day as this falls after their exams). The timetable is collapsed for the day and pupils have the opportunity to take part in activities which would not normally be on the curriculum. These activities are designed to enrich the curriculum and also allow pupils to experience trips offsite as well as topic days, and work related learning.

To enhance in-school activities on these days, we arrange for guest speakers, theatre companies and agencies to come and give talks, take workshops and lead sessions. These activities often require a morning or whole day which cannot be accommodated within the normal school timetable. As you will see there are also some day trips available and information about these will be issued prior to the trip with full details of costing and arrangements.

To enable us to give each pupil the opportunity to benefit from these activities, we are requesting a voluntary contribution towards the cost. Feedback from our Parent Forum Group has suggested that, rather than requesting contributions be made prior to each activity during the course of the year, we should request one payment to be made at the start of the academic year (this will not include offsite trips or activities during Curriculum Enrichment Week in July).

In response to our Parent Forum Group we are, therefore, requesting a total contribution of £6 towards these activities during Year 11. This is a voluntary contribution but, without your continued support, it would be very difficult for the school to provide such a wide range of opportunities. Please complete and return the attached slip together with £6 (cheques made payable to Beaumont School) **by Friday 30th September**. You should send your money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name, form and 'Year 11 Contribution' clearly written on it. **This should be posted in the appropriate box outside the Finance Office.** Alternatively you can pay over the Internet.
