On the first Curriculum Enrichment Day this year we have been able to secure the services of an external provider, 'It's About Learning', who will be working with the students looking at memory mapping, learning styles and revision skills.

This will help all students as they approach their last year of GCSE courses and, for some, their first AS exams. The workshop will involve activities and strategies which the pupils will be able to use throughout the year in both their coursework and exams.
