Re: Year 7 Geography Fieldwork – 24th September 2009

On the 24th September, we are organising a Geography fieldwork day for Year 7. The year group will be split in half with LEA taking part in the morning and RNS in the afternoon. The other half of the day will be spent taking part in the Interform competition. The day will be spent investigating the River Lea in Wheathampstead as part of the current Year 7 Geography Curriculum focus on Rivers and Flooding.

The cost of the day will be £4.50 per pupil. This will cover the cost of the coaches to and from Wheathampstead. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet these costs from our own funds, and the day will only be able to go ahead if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution of £4.50 to school funds.

I would be grateful if you would complete the reply slip and return it to the Finance Office by Thursday September 17th. You can send your money or cheque (made payable to Beaumont School) in a sealed envelope with your son/ daughter's name, form and title 'Year 7 Geography Fieldwork' clearly written on it. This should be posted in the appropriate box outside the Finance Office.

Pupils will need to be in school at the usual time of 8.25am, and will be ready to leave school at the usual time of 3.25pm. Pupils do not need to wear school uniform for the whole day. However, they will be outside for part of the day and so will need to be equipped with clothing suitable for all weather conditions. In addition, a pair of Wellington boots and a spare set of clothes will be required. All pupils will also need to bring a packed lunch.
