VERULAM SCHOOL

Year 5 & 6 Maths for parents (yr 4, 5 & 6 children)

We will be offering a 6 week **evening course** for parents of children in years 4, 5 and 6 at Verulam School to show parents how to support their children with the maths curriculum and KS2 SATs and with real life maths at home.

The course will include:

- Using maths dictionaries to understand terminology
- Identifying different ways of solving maths problems
- Understanding and identifying strategies for calculating with whole numbers and decimals, and those for mental maths problems
- Knowing the principles of BODMAS, (the order of operations in expressions for calculations)
- Using a range of models to represent fractions, decimals and percentages

Modern Foreign Languages for Adults
