We are looking for a well motivated and enthusiastic full time teacher of mathematics to join our outstanding department. Teaching will be required at all levels in KS3 and KS4, with KS5 available for those with appropriate experience. You will be working within a very forward thinking, approachable and supportive team, teaching students who are interested and keen to make progress.

We consistently achieve good results in both GCSE and A level. The A level results are consistently in the upper quartile in terms of progression and we typically have around 90% or better grade C or above at GCSE, with around 35-40% of students achieving an A or A*. We have always had strong numbers taking A Level Maths and these have increased further this year, showing that the subject is well regarded by the student body.

Students are taught in setted groups throughout Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4. We use the Edexcel board for both GCSE and A Level.

The department is very well equipped and housed in a new build block with each room having an interactive screen and there is plentiful access to computer suites when required.
